

**BYLAW NO. 749**

IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

**A BYLAW TO AMEND THE LAND USE BYLAW**

**WHEREAS** pursuant to part 17 of the Municipal Government Act, the council of the Town of Killam enacts the following changes to Bylaw 736, the land use bylaw.

1. Section 3 (1) is amended by adding to the list of land use districts  
“DC Direct Control”
2. Section 17 is amended by adding  
“17 (5) Pursuant to section 641 of the Act, there is no appeal to the subdivision and development appeal board against a decision by council regarding a development permit application in a direct control district”
3. Lot 6 Block 13 Plan 6024AC, municipally known as 4914 – 54<sup>th</sup> Street, is reclassified from R1 Residential to DC Direct Control, and the accompanying the bylaw is amended to show that change.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Town of Killam, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

**THAT** the Land Use By-law No. 736 be hereby amended as follows:

Amend Schedule “A” Land Use District Map to change the land use designation of Lot 6 Block 13 Plan 6024AC from Residential (R1) to Direct Control (DC).

This Bylaw shall come into force and effect upon the date that it is finally passed.
