

**BYLAW NO. 751**  
OF THE  
TOWN OF KILLAM  
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

**BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF KILLAM IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO ESTABLISH A DEVELOPMENT APPEAL BOARD.**

**WHEREAS** pursuant to section 627 of the Municipal Government Act, Council of the Town of Killam, in the Province of Alberta authorizes:

1. THAT a development appeal board be established;
2. THAT the development appeal board herein established, or a committee hearing an appeal, not be formed by a majority of Councillors;
3. THAT each member shall be appointed for a term of not more than three years, but a person may be re-appointed upon expiry of his/her term.
4. THAT Bylaw 563 be rescinded.

This Bylaw shall come into force and effect upon the final passing thereof:
