BYLAW FOR ASSESSMENT SERVICES
OF THE
TOWN OF KILLAM
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF KILLAM IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO ESTABLISH THE POSITION FO ASSESSOR OF THE TOWN OF KILLAM.

WHEREAS Section 210 of the Municipal Government Act allows a Council to pass a bylaw establishing a position to carry out the powers, duties and functions of a designated officer;

AND WHEREAS Council of the Town of Killam wishes to establish the position of “assessor” as a designated officer under Section 284(d) of the Act;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KILLAM DULY ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Council hereby establishes the position of Assessor for the Town of Killam as a designated officer
2. That Gary Barber, Wainwright Assessment Group, be appointed as the Assessor for the Town of Killam
3. That Gary Barber shall be responsible to perform the duties of the Assessor as prescribed in the said Municipal Government Act as amended or repealed, And any other relevant statute or regulation or bylaw making reference to the Assessor
4. That the Assessor shall be subject to the supervision of and accountable to The Municipal Administrator
5. That the Assessor may further delegate any authority delegated by Council to The Assessor pursuant to section 212 of the Act
6. This bylaw comes into effect on the date of third reading.

Read for a third time, by unanimous consent this 18th day of May, 2006.
