

BYLAW NO. 764
OF THE
TOWN OF KILLAM
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF KILLAM, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ALLOWING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER FROM AMONG THE MEMBERS OF COUNCIL.

WHEREAS Section 150 of the Municipal Government Act gives Council the authority to appoint the Chief Elected Official from among the Councillors providing a bylaw is passed, and

WHEREAS the Section 151 states that a bylaw under section 150 must be passed at least 180 days before the general election, and section 150(3) states that such bylaw must be advertised.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Killam, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

THAT Council amend the Town of Killam election procedure from a Chief Elected Official to a Chief Appointed Official.

This Bylaw shall come into force and effect upon the date that it is finally passed.
