

BYLAW NO. 779
OF THE
TOWN OF KILLAM
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF KILLAM, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING THE TOWN OF KILLAM LAND USE BYLAW NO. 736.

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Killam considers it necessary to amend the Land Use Bylaw No. 736, and

WHEREAS the Council has the authority pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, Chapter M26, to amend the said Land Use ByLaw No. 736.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Killam, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

THAT the Land Use By-law No. 736 be hereby amended as follows:

Amend Schedule "A" Land Use District Map to change the land use designation of Block RT C, Plan RN 97 from Direct Control (DC) to Agriculture (A).

This Bylaw shall come into force and effect upon the date that it is finally passed.

READ a first time this 16th day of August, 2007.

READ a second time this 20th day of September, 2007.

READ a third time, by unanimous consent of the Councillors present, and finally passed this 20th day of September, 2007.
