

BYLAW NO. 782
OF THE
TOWN OF KILLAM
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

A bylaw of the Town of Killam, in the Province of Alberta for the purpose of amending Bylaw No. 767 to authorize Municipal council to operate and levy general rates for the supply of public utilities and services provided by the municipality.

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Killam considers it necessary to amend Bylaw No. 767, and

WHEREAS the Council has the authority pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, Chapter M26, to amend the said Bylaw No. 767

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Killam, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

THAT the Bylaw No. 767 be hereby amended as follows:

THAT the following segment of Bylaw No. 767 is amended to read:

3. Any existing prepayments (or deposits) held in trust with the Town of Killam shall be held by the Town of Killam until the tenant moves from the property (Bylaw 638 is grandfathered), and at that time the prepayment shall be refunded to the tenant, except for utility amounts owing, and the account shall revert to the property owner's name.

READ A THIRD AND FINAL TIME THIS 1ST DAY OF NOVEMBER, 2007 A.D. AND FINALLY PASSED.
