**BYLAW #772:
LAND USE
BYLAW #736
AMENDMENT** Bylaw No. 772, a bylaw of the Town of Killam, in the Province of Alberta for the purpose of amending the Town of Killam Land Use Bylaw #736. This bylaw is to amend Schedule “A” Land Use District Map to change the land use designation of Lot 13, Block 3, Plan RN97 from Commercial (C1) to Residential (R1).

First Reading of Bylaw #772 given at the Town of Killam Regular Council on June 21, 2007.

No written submissions received in response to the Notice of Public Hearing that was advertised in the June 26 and July 3, 2007 editions of the Community Press and no members of the public were present at the hearing.

Mayor James asked Council for questions.

There were none.

DECISION

Councillor Grant and all council members present had no objection to the changing of the Land Use designation. Council decided to postpone the 2nd and 3rd Reading of Bylaw #772 to the regular meeting of July 19, 2007.
