

BYLAW NO. 846
OF THE TOWN OF KILLAM
(hereinafter referred to as “the Municipality”)
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF KILLAM IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, CANADA TO AUTHORIZE THE CLOSING TO PUBLIC TRAVEL AND DISPOSING OF PORTIONS OF A PUBLIC ROAD IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER M-26, STATUTES OF ALBERTA 2000, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS: the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel and;

WHEREAS: application has been made to Council to have the portion of the road closed and;

WHEREAS: the Council of the Town of Killam deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and thereafter disposing of same; and;

WHEREAS: notice of intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act: and;

NOW THEREFORE: that the Council of the Town of Killam in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel and dispose of the following described road, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

CITATION

1. This Bylaw may be cited as: “Road Closure – Lisgar Avenue from the eastern property line of Lot 4, Block 26, Plan 162 1621 to the western property line of the quarter section NE18-44-13-W4M”.

DEFINITIONS

2. In this Bylaw:
 - (a) “Road” shall mean all of that portion of Lisgar Avenue from the eastern property line of Lot 4, Block 26, Plan 162 1621 to the western property line of the quarter section NE18-44-13-W4M as shown as the crosshatched area on the sketch attached hereto as Schedule “A”. Schedule "A" to this Bylaw forms part of this Bylaw.

ROAD CLOSURE

3. The Road is hereby closed.

This Bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon the date of third and final reading and upon approval from the Minister of Transportation.
