

BYLAW NO. 851
OF THE TOWN OF KILLAM
(hereinafter referred to as “the Municipality”)
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF KILLAM IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, CANADA TO AMEND BYLAW 846 BY CHANGING THE DESCRIPTION OF THE ROAD CLOSURE/SKETCH/PLAN.

AND WHEREAS: the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M26.1, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, as amended and Section 63(2)(i) permits changes to the substance of the bylaw to bring out more clearly what is considered to be the meaning of Bylaw 846.

The legal description of Bylaw 846 is described as:

“All of that portion of Lisgar Avenue from the eastern property line of Lot 4, Block 26, Plan 162 1621 to the western property line of the quarter section NE18-44-13-W4M as shown as the shaded area on the sketch attached hereto as Schedule “A”.

The legal description is amended in Bylaw 851 by changing the legal description and is described as:

“**LISGAR AVENUE EXEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS** as shown as the shaded area on the sketch attached hereto as Schedule “A””

This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the date of final passing.

Bylaw 846 is hereby amended.
