**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF KILLAM IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA
FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROHIBITING THE MISUSE OR ABUSE OF THE
MUNICIPAL WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM.**

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of the *Municipal Government Act*, Statutes of Alberta, 1994, Chapter M-26.1 and amendments thereto, provides that the Council of a Municipality may pass a Bylaw making it an offence to abuse the water supply system through excessive watering of lawns.

Now **THEREFORE**, the Council of the Town of Killam, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows

SECTION 1.

SHORT TITLE

1.1 This Bylaw may be cited as the Town of Killam Water Restriction Bylaw.

SECTION 2.

DEFINITIONS

- 2.1 "Bylaw Enforcement Officer" means a Bylaw Enforcement Officer appointed by the Municipality pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, to enforce the Municipality's Bylaws, and includes members of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police and, when authorized, a Special Constable.
- 2.2 "Lawn" shall mean the grass portion of a lot excluding flower beds, trees, shrubs, and vegetable gardens.

SECTION 3.

WATER RESTRICTION REGULATIONS

- 3.1 Watering of lawns in Killam shall be restricted to the hours of 6:00am to 10:00am, and 6:00pm to midnight daily as follows:
- a) Even numbered improvements on even numbered calendar days
 - b) Odd numbered improvements on odd numbered calendar days
- 3.2 The water restriction shall not apply to newly seeded lawns, newly lain sod, flower beds, trees, or vegetable gardens.

SECTION 4.

PENALTIES

4.1 Any person who disobeys the regulations at Section 3 above is guilty of an offence and is liable to the following penalties:

a) 1 st offence	written warning
b) 2 nd offence	a fine of \$20.00
c) 3 rd offence	a fine of \$40.00
d) 4 th & subsequent offences	a fine of \$80.00

SECTION 5.

VIOLATION TAGS

5.1 A Bylaw Enforcement Officer is hereby authorized and empowered to issue a Violation Tag to any person who the Bylaw Enforcement Officer has reasonable and provable grounds to believe has contravened any provision of this Bylaw.

SECTION 6.


EFFECTIVE DATE
