

**TOWN OF KILLAM**  
**IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**  
**BYLAW NO. 844**

**BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF KILLAM IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FOR THE NUMBER OF COUNCILLORS AND THE ELECTION OF THE CHIEF ELECTED OFFICIAL (MAYOR).**

**WHEREAS** Section 143(2) of the Municipal Government Act , RSA 2000, C M-26 as amended from time to time, provides that a Council of a City or Town consist of 7 Councilors unless the Council passes a bylaw specifying a higher or lower odd number;

**AND WHEREAS** The Council of the Town of Killam currently provides that the Municipal Council of the Town of Killam shall consist of six (6) and one (1) Chief Elected Official known as the Mayor in the Town of Killam, whom is elected by the eligible electors of the Town of Killam as a whole;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Town of Killam in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. The Municipal Council of the Town of Killam shall consist of five (5) councilors, one of whom is the Chief Elected Official.
2. The Chief Elected Official shall remain to be elected by the eligible electors of the Town of Killam as a whole.
3. The Chief Elected Official shall have the same term as other councilors.
4. This bylaw shall come into effect at the time of the next general election.

This Bylaw shall come into force and effect pm THIRD and FINAL Reading.
