

BYLAW NO. 840
OF THE TOWN OF KILLAM
(hereinafter referred to as "the Municipality")
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF KILLAM IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, CANADA TO AUTHORIZE THE CLOSING TO PUBLIC TRAVEL AND DISPOSING OF PORTIONS OF A PUBLIC ROAD IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER M-26, STATUTES OF ALBERTA, 2000, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS: the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel and;

WHEREAS: application has been made to Council to have the portion of the road closed and;

WHEREAS: the Council of the Town of Killam deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and thereafter disposing of same; and;

WHEREAS: notice of intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act: and;

NOW THEREFORE: that the Council of the Town of Killam in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel and dispose of the following described road, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

CITATION

1. This Bylaw may be cited as: "Road Closure – 58 Street from 50 Avenue to 51A Avenue".

DEFINITIONS

2. In this Bylaw:
 - a) "Road" shall mean all of that portion of 58 Street from 50 Avenue to 51A Avenue as shown as the crosshatched area on the sketch attached hereto as Schedule "A". Note that Schedule "A" to this Bylaw forms part of this Bylaw.

ROAD CLOSURE


3. The Road is hereby closed.


This Bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon the date of third and final reading and upon approval from the Minister of Transportation.




