

BYLAW #868
OF THE
TOWN OF KILLAM
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF KILLAM IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO REPEAL BYLAW 817A, ALSO CITED AS THE RECREATION FEE BYLAW.

WHEREAS pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M26 of the statutes of Alberta 2000 as amended, the power to pass a bylaw under this or any other enactment includes a power to amend or repeal a bylaw; and

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Killam in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Citation

1.1 This bylaw may be cited as the "Town of Killam Repeal 817A Bylaw".

2. Provisions

2.1 That Bylaw 817A, the Recreation Fee Bylaw be hereby repealed.

3. Severability

3.1 If any term of this Bylaw is found to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable by a court or tribunal having the jurisdiction to do so, that term is to be considered to have been severed from the rest of this Bylaw, and the rest of the Bylaw remains in force unaffected by that finding or by the severance of that term.

4. Enactment

4.1 This bylaw shall take effect at the date of the final passing thereof.
