Council Meeting Highlights

September 19, 2024



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- Bylaw 889 – Master Rates Amending Bylaw was finalized include permit fees for solar and wind developments.
 - Policy D013 – Sidewalk, Curb & Gutter Management Policy has been accepted and will provide a general guide of priorities and maintenance of sidewalks, curbs and gutters in town.
 - The Fortis Franchise Fee for 2025 will remain the same as 2024 at 10%.
 - The proposal from Hi-Signs was accepted for 2 new town entrance signs. The planning and design stage will begin immediately with construction and completion in the Spring of 2025.
 - The Parkland Regional Library 2025 proposed budget was approved with an increase of \$0.63/capita.
 - Cllr McDermott was appointed to apply to be a municipal representative on the Alberta Health regional advisory council.
 - Cllr Fee was appointed to be a council representative on the Parkland Regional Library Board.
 - A new culvert and road work on 49 Street south of 49 Ave at an approximate cost of \$91,000 will be included in the 2025 budget.
 - Cllr Fee will meet with Killam Ag Society to outline the capital projects for the Agriplex/Arena scheduled for 2025.
 - Town of Killam Office will be closed September 30, 2024 in recognition of Truth & Reconciliation Day.
