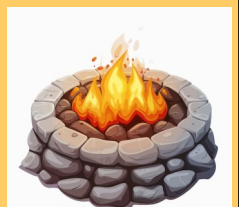

### Fire Pit Permits Required in Town

Bylaw #871 requires a Fire Pit Permit for all in-ground fire pits or outdoor fireplaces within Killam. If you have recently **added** or **replaced** a fire pit, please **renew** your permit. To apply for a permit, please visit the Flagstaff Regional Emergency Services Society (FRESS) website at [www.flagstaff-ress.org](http://www.flagstaff-ress.org)

Permits are **FREE**, however fines for non-compliance range from \$200-\$2000



## Animal Control - Bylaw #815A

Cats and Dogs within the Town of Killam:

- **MUST** Be licensed **annually** (if over 6 months of age)
- **MUST** Be under the control of the Owner when on property other than their own—there are NO off leash areas in the Town of Killam
- **MUST** Have Owners responsible for removal of their pets' defecation
- **MUST** Not annoy or disturb the peace of others (excessive barking)
  - \* Fines range from \$100 to \$2,500
  - \* The cost to release a pet impounded by the Town is \$25 for the first day, \$15 per day following.

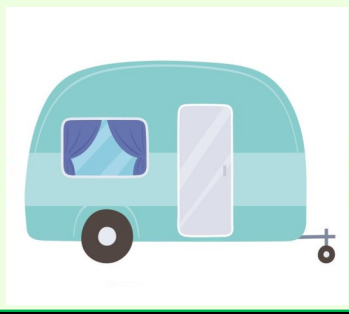
### With Warmer Weather Approaching, Remember to Keep Killam Clean!!!

An unsightly premise lacking general upkeep interferes with **Bylaw 777B**. This may include grass that has not been recently mowed, out of control weeds, accumulation of rubbish, vehicles parked on the property without plates and other inoperable machinery.

Any kind of trailer, unhitched and parked on a public road violates **Bylaw 773D**.

# Thinking of Building a Fence?

## **Do I need a permit to build a fence on my property?**

Permits for fences in a residential district with a maximum height of 1 meter (3.3 ft) in the front yard or 2 meters (6.6 ft) in the rear or side yard are not required. All relevant provisions in Section 40 of the Land Use Bylaw 880 still apply. Fences for homes in other districts will also fall under the same provision if the property is being used for residential purposes.

If the applicable regulations of the Land Use Bylaw 880 are not adhered to, enforcement fines will be issued and the fence may be removed at your expense and the Town of Killam will not be held liable for damages caused to fences due to snow removal and/or sidewalk replacement.
